Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Pro-Vision Charter School District leadership team has been closely monitoring news and updates regarding the COVID-19 virus in order to make the best decisions for our Pro-Vision Academy community. As a result, we are taking the following proactive steps to protect our community from COVID-19 and to assist our area's public health officials in their goal of containing the virus across the Houston area:

- **Students are not to report to school on Friday, March 13, 2020.** When students return to school, teachers will prepare additional assignments that students are to complete in order to compensate for lost instructional time.
- **Students will return to school on Tuesday, March 31, 2020.**
- **Parents, we need your support** in ensuring your students read and stay academically engaged during this break, and that they complete the additional assignments when they return to school.
- **All Pro-Vision Academy Charter School District schools and offices will be closed next week: Friday, March 13 — Monday, March 30, 2020.** Key district personnel will be using these days to plan next steps for safe and secure operations of our campuses.
- **All district after-school activities, field trips and gatherings have been cancelled until further notice.** While we fully recognize how important extracurricular and non-academic activities are to our students, their health and safety is our first concern.
- **COVID-19 Updates to the Pro-Vision Academy community will continue to be available on our website and local news stations.** We are committed to providing you with important information as soon as it is available.

Our entire community must do everything possible to help reduce the likelihood of transmitting the virus to those in our community who are at increased risk. Please stay informed and stay healthy. Thank you for entrusting your children to us to provide them a quality education.
