Monday

SAT Vocabulary Words Definitions: Today you will start SAT Vocabulary. For students with access to computers you will define 5 vocabulary words from the SAT. Students who don't have computer access at home can use your cell phones to define the 5 vocabulary words. On a sheet of paper write the vocabulary words and definitions, take a picture of your work and send it to the Google classroom.

SAT Vocabulary Words: aggravate, bridle, eminent, faze, confidant.

Student Choice Reading: For your daily reading, read a book, magazine, newspaper, instruction manual or directions for a product (like a college/university) for at least 30 minutes a day. Keep a reading log that you will add to each day with a response to what you read. It could be a summary, critique of the text, any response to what you have read.

SAT Vocabulary Words Sentences: Today you will continue to work with SAT Vocabulary. Students will create (2) sentences for each of the 5 SAT Vocabulary words defined on Monday 4/13/2020. Write your complete sentences on a sheet of paper, take a picture of your work and send it to the Google classroom.
