-  Waft the sulfur with her hand, and then smell it.

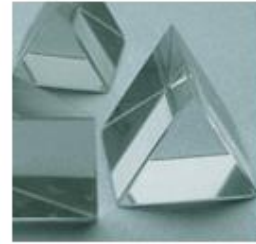
