The purpose of this communication is to share information regarding our state accountability. Recently official state rankings were released by TEA and growth was seen across the district. I'm thrilled at the work and successes being rightfully recognized throughout the district.

At our charter district, we are working towards Becoming Extraordinary! Our current ratings signal the progress we are making. With that being said, we still have a lot of work to do. Our goals are to get to that next level of excellence. Together we will accomplish these goals!

**OVERALL RATING:** Drumroll, please.....While The Pro-Vision Academy is Not Rated, we were ONE POINT from a C rating for the district. We achieved 69 points out of 100. Seventy (70) points would earn a C rating.

So, what does that mean? It means that with continued work and commitment PVA should be able to reach a C rating, or even higher.

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) looks at three categories and our achievements in each, are as follows:

**Student Achievement:** student achievement shows how much students know and are able to do at the end of the school year

**SCORE:** 79 out of 100 which is a C rating

**School Progress:** school progress shows how students perform over time and how that growth compares to similar schools

**SCORE:** 72 out of 100 which is a C rating

**Closing the Gaps:** closing the gaps shows how well different student groups within a school are performing (I.e. Economically Disadvantaged or Gifted and Talented)

**SCORE:** 30 out of 100 which means we missed the mark and will be laser focused on improving this area



No matter the year or circumstances, PVA has always maintained a reputation for serving our students with high academic standards and goals. We will continue to provide quality instruction and programs that interest our students.
