## SUBJECT: INTERIM SUPERINTENDENT'S CORONAVIRUS UPDATE

Pro-Vision Charter School District's Interim Superintendent, Warner Ervin, has announced that Pro-Vision Schools will extend the suspension of normal district operations through Friday, April 10, 2020, in an effort to support the national strategy to arrest the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Houston area continues to see an increasing number of confirmed cases of COVID-19, and health officials report that, as more individuals are tested, this number will continue to increase. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has reported that practicing social distancing is a vitally important strategy in containing COVID-19.

We are committed to providing structured, meaningful ways to serve our students during this closure. On Monday, March 16, district and campus level leaders began preparation and planning to develop district-level supports that will provide remote instruction to our students. No later than Monday, March 23, 2020, Pro-Vision Academy administrators and teachers will release instructional information regarding remote learning opportunities for our students.
