Dear Pro-Vision Academy (PVA) Community:

It is with optimism that I greet you at the beginning of our new year and our spring semester! Together our community has worked for the benefit of our students to provide a quality education in a safe environment.

With safety in mind, we must be aware that COVID-19 is still with us. We must remain diligent with our efforts to stay safe and healthy. I have listed below some key considerations to support a safe learning environment:

- **Vaccinations** for everyone who is eligible to get vaccinated and/or boosted for COVID-19. Data has shown that vaccines are effective at preventing severe symptoms of the disease; and,
- **Masking, social distancing, and sanitizing** must continue to be practiced regardless of vaccination status; and,
- **Children and staff who are feeling ill should stay home and get tested** to help prevent the spread of infection; and,
- **Testing** at key milestones is critical.

The current CDC recommendations for a positive COVID-19 test, regardless of vaccination status include the following:

- Stay home for 5 days.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
- If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

At PVA, we will be diligent about **everyone wearing a mask**. The mask must be worn appropriately, for example, covering both the nose and the mouth. This is important for everyone's safety.

We all look forward to a time when our lives will not be dominated by the threat of COVID-19. That time is not yet here, so we must continue to proactively conduct ourselves accordingly. It is my sincere hope that we all remain safe and healthy! We will continue to update our PVA Community as information becomes available.
